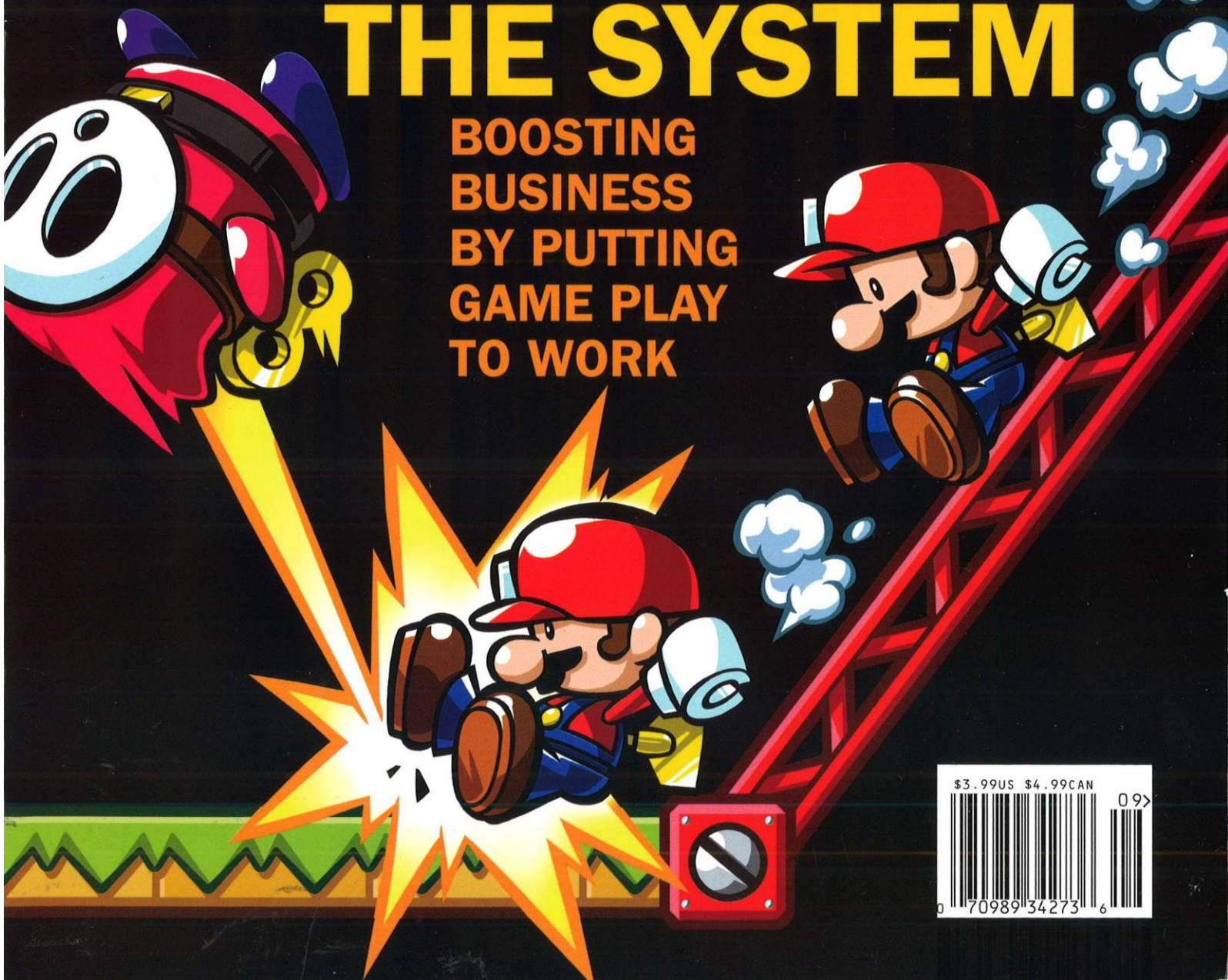

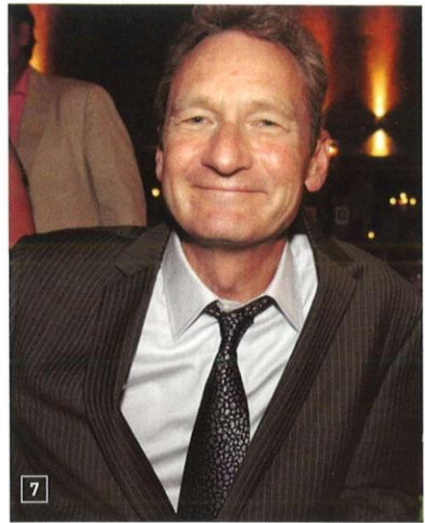
## Summer Celebrations

Willows Lodge holds its annual Iron Vintner Challenge, DeLille Cellars celebrates Bastille Day, and much more.

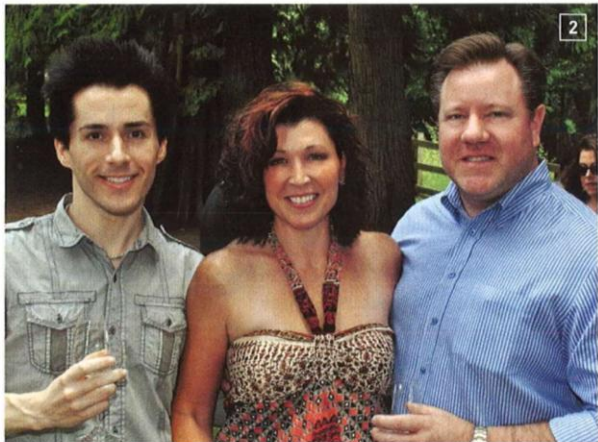
